

The Herne Hill Primary School Board has endorsed this schedule, setting out the maximum anticipated amounts of Contributions and Charges for 2021. The schedule is broken into three sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that might be incurred throughout the school year. Costs to parents are carefully considered before inclusion.

These are the items that each child needs to maximise learning opportunities. Some items are needed every day (e.g. pencils, pens etc.) and others, according to the timetable (e.g. library bag). Please note that it may be necessary to replace some items throughout the year as the need arises.

2. CONTRIBUTIONS

Contributions have been added as a separate item on the Items for Personal Use list.

3. CHARGES FOR EXTRA COST OPTIONAL COMPONENTS

A breakdown of estimated **charges** for your child's participation in incursions, excursions, activities, etc. for 2021 has been included in the schedule below. These figures have been calculated based on the charges this year. Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity. The amounts indicated on the schedule represent the **maximum** charged for scheduled activities in 2021. As in the past, you will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches.

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4. CALCULATE YOUR ANTICIPATED CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES

To calculate your anticipated contribution and charges, select the costs relevant to your child's year level from each section and tally them on the table below.

5. P & C VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION

After community consultation, the P & C have decided to retain the P & C Voluntary Contribution as a means of supporting the school. It may also be paid as part of the booklist or separately, whichever is more convenient.
